WHAT'S THE BIG PROBLEM??

Identifying the central conflict in a story helps the reader understand what the stakes are. Conflict is what drives the character's to take action. The antagonist wants something that sets things in motion that the hero must stop. A good way to identify conflict is to think If/Then.
