The Girl Who Built Bridges

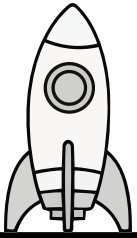

Trophy Thief

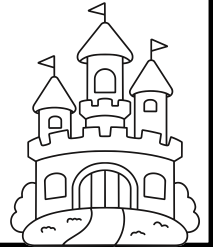
The school's biggest sports trophy disappears right before a big assembly. A group of kids search for clues and question suspects. They must solve the mystery before the whole school finds out.

Secrets of the Garden

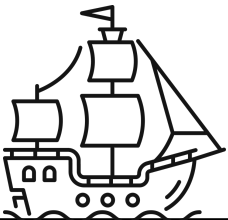
This book teaches how seeds turn into plants step by step. It explains what plants need, like sunlight and water. Readers learn how plants help people and animals live.

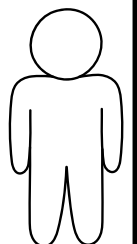
